Development vs Production

- Programmers vs Sysadmins
- Development
 - Instant reloading
 - Single machine
- Production
 - No instant reload
 - Mostly more Mongrel / (Ebb ;)) instances
 - Even on many servers

Capistrano

- Created by Jamis Buck
- Executing tasks on multiple (remote) systems
- Using recipes (ruby code) do do additional stuff
- Comes as a gem

Capistrano and Rails

- Easy to deploy applications or run migrations
- Supports multiple version control systems
- Restart (Mongrel) servers
- Perform additional tasks (symlinking stuff, etc)

Webistrano

- Created by Jonathan Weiss
- Web front-end (in Rails, yeeha!) for Capistrano
- Multiple projects
- Multiple users
- Email notifications
